



POSTAL VOTING REQUEST

Please note only electors who are (or will be) registered individually for a particular election or referendum are entitled to vote by proxy at that election or referendum.

Please complete the form following the guidelines below.

Section 1

Enter your address.

Section 2

Enter your full name.

Section 3

You need to decide if you wish to have a postal vote:

- Until further notice this is a permanent vote;
- For elections that you already know will be held on a particular date;
- For all elections until a set date (you may be on holiday or otherwise unable to vote in person at a polling station until this date).

Section 4

This application, if completed correctly, allows you to have a postal vote for all elections you are entitled to vote in.

Section 5

If you will be away from home, then you can choose to have your ballot papers sent to an address other than the one shown in Section 1. If you choose for your ballot paper to be sent to a different address other than the address you are registered at you must give a reason for the alternative address. The postal vote must be completed by you, no one else can vote on your behalf. If you wish to appoint a proxy to vote on your behalf please see www.birmingham.gov.uk/vote or telephone the helpline on 0121 303 2731.

Section 6

Electors who wish to vote by post for any election are required to provide their date of birth and specimen of their signature. Please note that your date of birth and signature must be kept within the borders provided. Failure to do so will mean this application will not be valid.

Your personal identifiers will be stored securely. Each time you vote by post, your signature and date of birth provided on the postal voting statement will be checked against these identifiers, to ensure your postal vote remains secure.
